- 1 Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer**
March - Early April: Treatment with broadleaf weed control.
- 2 Liquid Weed Control with Light Fertilizer**
May: Provides post emergent control for dandelions, clover, chickweed, and many other weeds.
- 3 Spring Fertilizer**
May - June: Enhances turf growth and greening prior to the stress of summer heat.
- 4 Insect Control with Light Fertilizer**
June - July: Controls multiple varieties of lawn damaging insects.
- 5 Early Fall Fertilizer**
September - October: Ideal for recovering from the heat stress of summer. Promotes new growth from established turf and provides the necessary nutrients for fall seeding.
- 6 Winterization Fertilizer**
October - November: Nourishes the lawn throughout winter months and provides for quick spring green-up.

Deluxe Lawn Care Package

- 1 Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer**
March - Early April: Treatment with broadleaf weed control.
- 2 Liquid Weed Control with Light Fertilizer**
April - May: Provides post emergent control for dandelions, clovers, chickweed, and many other weeds.
- 3 Soil Testing**
April - May: Provides an excellent measure of soil fertility and the amount of available nutrients in the soil. A detailed lab analysis will be provided.
- 4 Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer**
May - June: Enhances turf growth and greening prior to the stress of summer heat.
- 5 Preventive Fungicide #1**
May - June: Offers full-spectrum control of significant turf diseases, e.g., dollar spot, brown patch, red thread, and leaf spot.
- 6 Surface Insect Control with Light Fertilizer**
June - July: Controls multiple varieties of lawn damaging insects.
- 7 Preventive Fungicide #2**
July - August: Extends the effectiveness of disease control further into the summer months.
- 8 Grub Control**
July - August: Prevents late summer damage by killing these pests when they are most active.
- 9 Early Fall Fertilizer**
September - October: Ideal for recovering from the heat stress of summer. Promotes new growth from established turf and provides the necessary nutrients for fall seeding.
- 10 Core Aeration**
September: Loosens compacted soil, permitting a higher availability of nutrients to produce new shoots and roots and thereby improving the overall health of the lawn.
- 11 Lime Treatment**
September - October: An important aspect of lawn care, which brings acidic soil into the proper PH range and maintains the appropriate balance within that range.
- 12 Winterization Fertilizer**
October - November: Nourishes the lawn throughout winter months and provides for quick spring green-up.
